

**12th International Euro-Asia Research Conference  
in Barcelona, Spain, June the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2006**

**Call for Papers**

***Intensified Investments and Exchanges between Asia and the West  
- organization and control -***

Following a number of conferences held in France, Ireland, Norway, Japan and China since 1994, the Twelfth Euro-Asia Research Conference will take place in Barcelona (Spain), on June the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2006. Research contributions addressing any aspect of ***Intensified Investments and exchanges between Asia and the West – organization and control*** are welcome. Besides this theme, other papers in the fields of economics and management, and related to Asia, may be submitted.

The conference is a joint undertaking between University of Barcelona (Spain), Nanchang University (P.R. of China), Yokohama National University (Japan), the IAE of Poitiers (Poitiers University, France), the IAE of Pau (*Université de Pau & des Pays de l'Adour*, France), the *Institut National des Télécommunications* (INT, France), the School of East Asian Studies, University of Sheffield (England) and the University of Limerick (Ireland).

The Conference is intended to bring together researchers engaged in Management, Economics and related fields from Europe, Asia and other parts of the World. Ph. D. candidates are also strongly encouraged to submit proposals for papers.

**Conference Venue, Conference Fee**

University of Barcelona, Barcelona, Spain. .

The conference fee is **160 €** and covers two lunches, two dinners, coffee breaks, and a copy of conference proceedings.

**Accommodation and travel**

Available funding does not allow the organizing committee to provide financial support to participants for accommodation and travel expenses. However, special prices will be negotiated with hotels or academic accommodation facilities located in Barcelona close to the conference venue.

**Submission Rules**

Papers, in English, Catalan, Castilian or in French, should be original and not submitted for publication elsewhere. They may either be related to a particular country or be comparative. Papers accepted for presentation at the conference will be published as Conference Proceedings. Furthermore, a number of selected papers will be published in a scholarly journal or as a book.

**A two-page abstract** in English, Catalan, Castilian or French (including bibliography) should be submitted **by December 15, 2005** to Ms Barbara Merigeault, IAE of Poitiers (France) at the following e-mail address: bmerigeault@iae.univ-poitiers.fr

A title page with a complete list of authors, their academic position, addresses, phone, fax number and E-mail should be included separately. The decision of the Scientific Committee will be communicated to the authors by 15 January 2006.

**The final paper**, including an abstract of around 300 words, should be forwarded **by March 15, 2006**. Length should not exceed 6,000 words or 15 single-spaced pages (including tables, figures, and references). Papers should be submitted in hard copy (or by e-mail as an attachment) as well as on disc (Word 6 or a later version). Although papers in Catalan, Castilian or French (including an abstract in

English) are accepted, all conference participants will be required to use slides in English in order to be widely understood.
